Our Heritage

InterVarsity Christian Fellowship/USA traces its roots to evangelical British university students of the 1870s. The first InterVarsity chapter in the United States began in 1938 at the University of Michigan, and in 1941 InterVarsity was incorporated. Over the last 70 years, hundreds of thousands of students have graduated as InterVarsity alumni and offered strong, thoughtful, caring leadership in churches and every sector of society. We were a founding member of the International Fellowship of Evangelical Students (IFES.org) in 1947. Through the IFES, we currently partner with indigenous ministries in 154 countries.




Our Ministry

- Campus Fellowships: nearly 900 chapters focus on undergraduates (including athletes, artists, international and nursing students, and members of fraternities and sororities), graduate students, and faculty members
- Bible Studies: small gatherings for students and faculty to learn from the Bible about Jesus and living as Christians
- Conferences: large events off campus offer biblical perspectives about social issues and skills, rooted in Scripture
- **Resources:** books from InterVarsity Press (IVP), video and design from 2100 Productions, and other resources



- Missions Projects: three-day to three-month projects, often among the poor and marginalized, teach students about sharing the gospel in both word and deed
- Evangelism: student-led events share the good news of Jesus Christ on campus
- Leadership Training Programs: staff-led experiences motivate and equip students to lead on campus and beyond
- Mentoring: guided instruction fosters Christian maturity among students
- Student Missions Conference: Urbana, the largest conference of its type in North America, calls people to join in God's global mission wherever they are URBANA



Our Budget

InterVarsity's national budget is over \$110 million per year. Funding is received primarily through the generous support of individuals, churches, and organizations committed to student ministry. The sale of books and fees charged for conferences help support our ministry.

Our Finances





*Core = those who participate in at least 50% of activities. InterVarsity touches over 100,000 lives each year.


